

Exploring the Petroglyphs Through the Lens of Photography

A Nature Photography Workshop by Renowned Photographer, Lewis Kemper.

The workshop will consist of three parts: it will begin with a classroom lecture and slideshow, followed by photography in the field, and conclude with a review and critique session.

The classroom presentation will address light and composition, discussing the quality and direction of light, rules of composition, compositional tips and more. You may want to bring paper and pen for note taking.

The field session will include a trip into the Petroglyph National Monument through the Piedras Marcadas Canyon Trail, where you will be photographing petroglyphs and scenery.

For this portion of the program you will need your cameras, lenses, tripod (or other supports), digital storage cards and any other photo gear you use on a regular basis such as cable release and filters.

After sunset, we will return to the classroom to download images and enjoy a light dinner. Two computer stations will be provided. If you have your own laptop, we recommend bringing it, along with a card reader and a flash drive, for transferring the images to Lewis's computer for the slideshow. There will be a light dinner at the classroom while we are preparing images for review.
