- Is proven to lead to better math outcomes for our students by constantly reinforcing and connecting math skills across disciplines






Integrated math lends itself to investigations that allow students to explore math for themselves and see how it relates to the real world and future careers

PATHWAYS IN THE COMMON CORE

Standard vs. Supported Mathematics

Standard

For students who have strong math skills, the standard Integrated Mathematics track will see them able to advance to Calculus by senior year with one math course per year, a true "college prep" course progression

Students who struggle with math or want additional help will receive an extra math class with a different teacher and educational technology to build the skills necessary to get to grade level as quickly as possible. Students who reach grade level may withdraw from support courses
